The goods and services shown below are those we can provide to our customers. You may choose only the items you desire. However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

Basic Services of Funeral Director and Staff

Our fee for the services of funeral director and staff includes, but is not limited to, staff to respond to initial request for services; arrangements conference with family or responsible party; arrangement of funeral; preparation and filing of necessary authorization and permits; recording vital statistics; preparation and placement of obituary notices; staff assistance prior to, during and following, coordination with those providing other portions of the funeral, e.g. cemetery, crematory and others. Also included in these charges are overhead expenses relative to our facility such as insurance, maintenance, and utilities expenses, secretarial and administrative cost, equipment and inventory cost.

This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials and forwarding or receiving remains).

Embalming

Embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.

Refer to the Casket Price List provided at the Funeral Home. If you choose a service where a rental casket is provided, the casket used for the service or viewing may have been used previously. If the casket has been used previously, the interior lining has been replaced.

Outer Burial Containers

A complete price list will be provided at the funeral home.

Forwarding of Remains to Another Funeral Home

Our charge for this service includes removal of remains, limited services of staff, embalming, securing necessary authorizations and local transportation to airport. This charge does not include visitation, rites, or ceremonies prior to forwarding of body.

Receiving of Remains From Another Funeral Home

Our charge for this service includes temporary shelter of remains, transportation of remains to cemetery and limited services of staff. This charge does not include visitation, rites or ceremonies.

Immediate Burials

Our charge for this service, without any attendant rites or ceremonies, includes the local transfer of the deceased into our care (within the 50 mile local radius), limited basic services of the funeral director and staff, obtaining necessary permits and authorizations, preparation and/or placement of newspaper notices, filing Social Security and Veteran's forms, refrigeration until burial, care of the deceased (limited to feature setting) and use of the facilities for private identification (limited to a next of kin or personal representative), and casket coach to local cemetery.

- Each cremation is performed by a Certified Crematory Technician. Our crematory is supervised by a highly professional staff.
- To prove our commitment to high cremation operating standards, our crematory is open for inspection by any family, anytime during normal operating business hours.
- Our "Worry Free Cremation" process proves that we are the cremation experts in the Greater Lexington area.

1. Safeguarding personal identity.

To ensure security, a personal identification band is placed on your loved one at the moment your loved one is transferred to our care.

2. Unique tracking system

Upon arrival, your loved one is logged into our tracking system and assigned an identification number, which is then stamped into a metal identification tag. This number is used to track every phase of the cremation process. Our tracking system includes date and time of arrival at our facility and name of the transfer technician. Personal belongings are catalogued and placed in a secure area for their return to the family.

3. Positive identification

Sometimes you can never be too careful. With our kind of business, this is especially true. Not all cremation providers take the extra step of requiring a positive identification at the funeral home. We do. You see, we feel it is our professional responsibility to ensure, without question, that the person entrusted to our care is indeed the person to be cremated. This relieves everyone who is involved of the possibility of mix-ups. We will perform minimum care (setting features) for your loved one and place them in a gown we provide. Then, we will ask you, or a representative, to positively identify him or her prior to cremation.

4. Checks and balances

Two individuals, a cremation technician and a funeral home staff member, will review all cremation paperwork and permits. This is to ensure authorizations and permits have been received and have been properly documented. Once all documentation is verified, both staff members must sign the cremation order prior to the cremation.

5. Cremation log book

Immediately prior to the cremation process, your loved one is taken to the cremation chamber and their personal identification is noted in our cremation log book. This log shows the name of the individual, date and time of the cremation, identification number and crematory operator's name. Our crematory log is dated and the start time is noted and initialed by a cremation technician before and after the cremation.

6. Details during, and after, the cremation

The crematory checklist, identification card and metal identification tag are placed on the outside of the cremation chamber during the cremation process. After the cremation is complete, the cremated remains are placed with the metal identification tag into the urn selected by the family. The identification card is placed in our permanent files.

Direct Cremation

Our charge for this service, without any attendant rites or ceremonies, includes the local transfer of the deceased into our care (within the 50 mile local radius), limited basic services of the funeral director and staff, obtaining necessary permits and authorizations, preparation and/or placement of newspaper notices, filing Social Security and Veteran's forms, refrigeration until cremation, use of private crematory and Standard Cremation Fee. State and local law does not require a casket for direct cremation. If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). *The containers we provide are: Corrugated Cardboard and Medium Density Fiberboard (MDF)*.

Our charge for Direct Cremation includes the Standard Cremation Fee.
