If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement describing the funeral goods and service you selected.

### Basic Services of Funeral Director and Staff

\$2,085.00

Staff to respond to initial request for service and arrangement conference, coordinating the details with the cemetery, crematory and/or other parties responsible for final disposition of the deceased; filing death certificate and necessary permits, preparation and placement of local obituary notice. The fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. *(This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving remains).*

### Embalming

\$1,085.00

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as a direct cremation or immediate burial.

<b>Immediate Burial</b>	\$4,325.00 to \$5,525.00
Our charge for immediate burial includes removal and shelter of remains, local transportation to cemetery, basic services of staff, coordination with third parties and necessary authorizations. This charge does not include the use of facilities and staff for any visitation, rites, or ceremonies, public or private prior to burial. The burial will be scheduled at the mutual convenience of the funeral home and cemetery, with no family or friends present.

 <b>Direct Cremation</b>	
Our charge for a direct cremation includes removal of remains, refrigeration, standard crematory fee, necessary authorizations, and basic services of staff. This charge does not include the use of facilities and staff for any visitation or ceremony, public or private, prior to cremation. If you want to arrange a direct cremation you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without coverings). The containers we provide are fiberboard or composite material.
