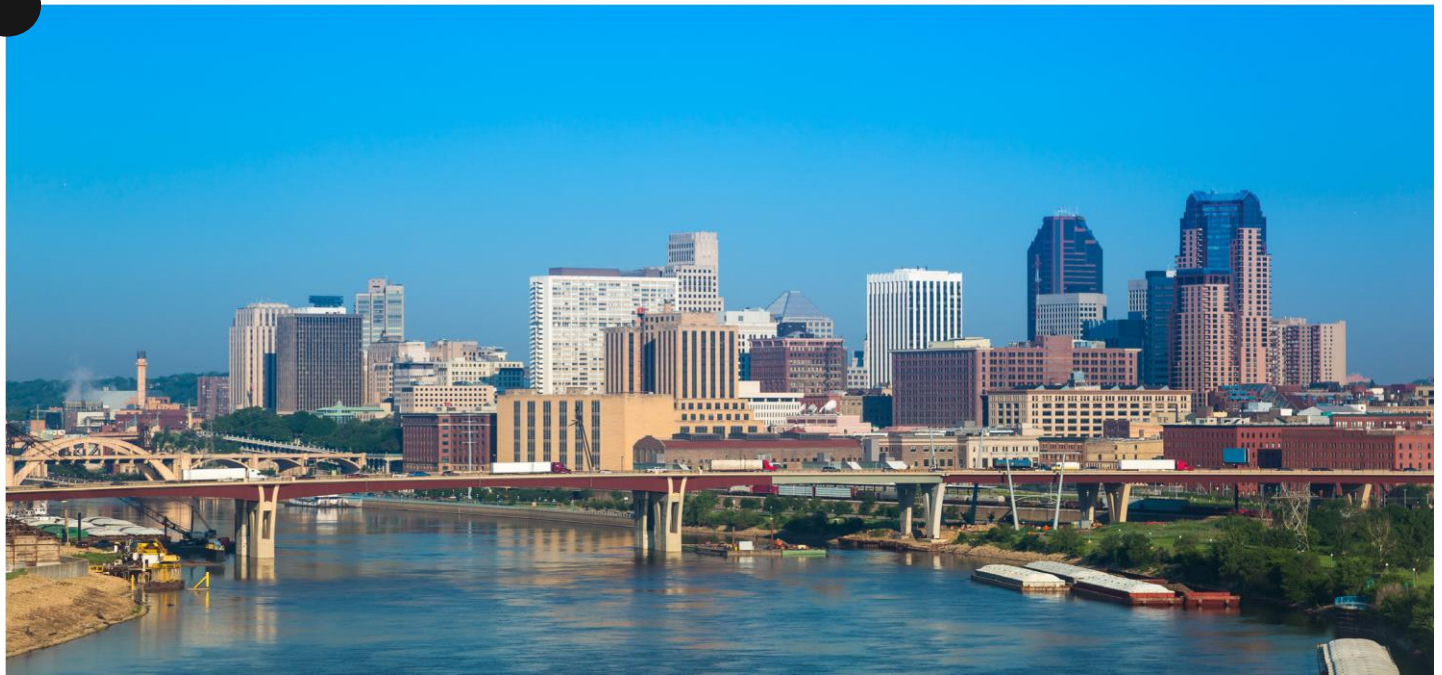

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law, however it may be necessary if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as a direct Cremation or Immediate Burial.

If you choose a funeral service where a rental casket is provided, the casket used for the funeral service may have been used in a previous funeral service. If the casket has been used in a previous funeral service, the interior lining has either been replaced or thoroughly cleaned.

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DIRECT CREMATION	\$3,240.00	to	\$3,460.00
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Our charges for a direct cremation without an attendant, rites or ceremonies includes transfer of remains, local transportation to the crematory, basic services of funeral director and staff, proportionate to services selected, cremation fee, and authorization. It does not include a cremation permit.

Federal Trade Commission Disclosure: If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). The containers we provide are corrugated fiberboard and hardboard.

Minnesota Disclosure: Minnesota law does not require you to purchase a casket for cremation. If you want to arrange a cremation, you can use a cremation container. A cremation container is a combustible, closed container that encases the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or corrugated cardboard and into which a dead human body is placed prior to insertion into a cremation chamber for cremation. The containers we provide are corrugated fiberboard and hardboard.
